

Maths

Just like me!

The first unit of White Rose Maths in Reception introduces key mathematical concepts through play and exploration.

Children focus on matching, sorting, and comparing objects based on size, colour, and shape. They begin to understand amounts by comparing quantities and explore size, weight, and capacity. The unit also introduces simple patterns and positional language, helping children describe the location of objects. This unit lays the foundation for number sense and spatial reasoning, using everyday experiences to develop early math skills.
